Common Area Updates: The annex flooring is being installed as of 04/25/2023, we anticipate this to take a couple of weeks. Starting on June 1, 2023 the price of a bag of ice will be increasing to \$2.00 per bag due to the increase in our pricing from the vendor. Building Operations Committee

The BOC has completed the following. On April 12, 2023, Pinpoint Detection located the leak between the fill pump and the square spa. They will be forwarding a proposal for the cost to make the repair. Upon receiving that the BOC will present to the board to move forward.

On April 13, 2023, an invitation bid was sent out to 4 security companies. Those bids have been asked to be returned to the BOC on or before May 1, 2023. Upon reviewing the bids, the BOC will make a presentation at the Board meeting for approval to move forward with that project.

A bid from Express Commercial Flooring was signed and deposit made to move forward with the installation of new flooring in the kitchen and annex. We are anticipating an installation day for the annex sometime around the first to middle of May. We will have to close the Annex to any activities at that time. We will be doing a mass emailing as well as posting the dates the Annex will not be available. We appreciate your patience during the installation.

The next meeting for the BOC is scheduled for May 8, 2023 at 9:30am in the conference room. We will also be offering a viewing of the meeting on zoom. We encourage any and all members to please feel free to sit in on our meeting.

Elections Committee

At the April 12, 2023, Board meeting, I presented to the Board for suggestion and approval the following. New procedures for approval on voting / counting day. Everyone is welcome to attend the counting and be an observer. There will be complete silence from all observers. There will not be any phones, cameras, or recording devices allowed. Observers will sit 5' apart from each other while votes are being tallied, during the tally of the tallies all observers will need to be 50' away from tables where the counting is taking place. We also presented to the Board to eliminate in person voting. Observers will be asked to sign a waiver indicating they will abide by the above requirements. During the 2024 voting period the yellow ballot box will be placed in the foyer of the club house. Each voter can place their own ballot in the box during open office hours. The election committee is collecting information on electronic voting. We will have more information on that type of voting. We will continue to offer paper ballot voting.

We have approved 3 new volunteers to the election committee. Judy Bolander, Dawn Meier, and John Huenemann. We thank them for their interest in helping out during the election season.

Finance Committee Mini Report

The Finance Committee invites all homeowners to attend their next meeting on May 22, 2023, at 11am in the clubhouse meeting room.

*The last Reserve Study created a replacement schedule for various Florence Garden's Homeowners assets that need upgrading or replacement. The Finance Committee consults this schedule when allocating funds for upgrades or replacement.

* One such item was the floor covering that is currently being replaced in the Annex.

* In order to be fiscally responsible, the Finance Committee monitors funds being held at the bank. Recently CDs were terminated due to low yield of .45 percent. \$1500 penalty was assessed. Currently \$300,000 of operating funds and \$450,000 of reserve funds is generating 3.27% annually.

*The operating fund generated \$2,449 in interest in 2022. The reserve interest income for 2022 was \$3,289. Currently (2023) both the operating fund and the reserve fund are generating in excess of \$10,000.

* The Finance Committee approved a \$3,000 request from the Decorations Committee that

includes wall decoration for the Annex, Honor wall banner for the clubhouse, and seasonal

decorations for the front entrance to the park. The Decorations committee also plans to replace cabinets in the Annex.





Arizona State Flower: The incredible saguaro cactus flower

Lean back and look up in May to see these white flowers that open and close within about 24 hours. This exotic display occurs nowhere else outside of the Sonoran Desert. Saguaros reach reproductive age and put forth their first flowers when they reach a height of approximately 7 feet, or when they are 30-60 years old.

Come join our next meeting Friday May 5 from 1-3 pm in the Annex. No meetings are planned for the summer months.



THE SAGUARO, HUB OF THE SONORAN DESERT

(From Tucson Audubon)

There is perhaps nothing more central to the Sonoran ecology than the saguaro cactus. It is not just the most iconic symbol of our region, it also serves as a source of food and shelter for 100 different local species. In fact, the saguaro is so vital to the ecosystem that it has earned the title of a keystone species—the fate of the Sonoran Desert is forever linked to the fate of the saguaro cactus. If the saguaro were gone, the effects on the ecosystem would be devastating.

Tucson Audubon Society recognizes the saguaro's position as the hub of the ecological network that is the Sonoran Desert. We have also seen how precarious its position can be: The wildfires that ravaged the Coronado and Tonto National Forests in recent years destroyed countless saguaros, threatening the insects, mammals, and birds that rely on them. We're working with many partners to re-establish saguaros both post-burn and to help them colonize areas projected to become viable saguaro habitat into the future.

Our saguaro population is at risk. But together we can make an impact.

With your help, we are undertaking a massive, 3-year effort to replant 14,000 saguaros. Our team is microtargeting the precise optimal locations for the new plants. We will ensure that the seed-lings are protected from the harsh sun and hungry animals until they are big and strong enough to defend themselves.






