Building Operations Committee

The BOC committee has collected 3 competitive bids from pool deck replacement companies.

The three(3) person team that collected bidding information for the pool deck replacement has done a great job. The team invited 8 contractors, 5 showed for a walk through, 3 submitted competitive bids. The whole team worked at qualifying the bids. Several questions and options were asked of each of the contractors to clarify in writing on their bids. This gave the BOC committee team the opportunity to compare each bid "apples to apples." On November 8th 2023. The board approved the BOC to move forward with Arrowhead Deck & Pool Company, with a not to exceed \$110,923.94. Work will begin on November 27, 2023 with a completion date of December 19, 2023. This is the schedule Arrowhead Deck & Pool Co. gave us.

At the October 25, 2023, board meeting, the board asked the BOC to proceed with collecting information and bids to upgrade the existing software/hardware for the office staff. At the November 8th board meeting, the BOC recommended the Board give the office staff a budget to upgrade their software/computers as needed for them to be compatible with their duties.

Currently the BOC is back working on programable thermostats. At the June 28th board meeting the BOC was asked to revisit and try to collect more competitive bids. There was too much of a price gap in the 2 contractors that did take the time to submit bids. I'm happy to say that currently, the team is working with 4 HVAC contractors.

The next BOC meeting will be December 8th 10:00 am, conference room. Our meetings are always open to committee members.

- 1. Preheat your oven to 350 degrees.
- Fill each phyllo shell (straight from the freezer is fine), with a small piece of brie (eyeball a 1 inch square and 1/2 inch thick piece) and a little cranberry sauce (about 1/2 a tablespoon).
 Bake for 5 minutes or until the cups begin to turn golden brown.
- 3. Remove from the oven, top with the orange zest and serve.

Notes: If you can't find phyllo cups (or if you want to try something different), use puff pastry instead.
