





Update on Volunteer Prepared Meals at Florence Gardens

We are continuing to plan and get volunteers to do twice monthly low cost main and bread or one side dish meals prepared by the kitchen. We have changed how we will get participants to help with providing desserts, salads and other sides to complement the hot dishes.

We are asking everyone to bring something to share and <u>not</u> asking for anyone to bring enough for 25 people. You do not have to sign up in advance as to what you are bringing. This is like what Caliente does in the summer. Tickets must be purchased in advance, will generally be \$6 and there will be a limit on the number sold.

There are planned menus through the end of January and lead cooks are needed to contact the kitchen manager (Julie McFarlane - 503-956-5461) to volunteer for meals that they can provide the menus and cooking for. This includes the January meals and the proposed prime rib dinner on February 7th and remaining dates of February 21st, March 6th or March 27th. The kitchen manager will assist including sizing up recipes and ordering ingredients.

There is interest in doing a prime rib dinner on February 7th. Dennis Parsons has agreed to help with this if we can get enough volunteers to chip in.







- 2 cloves garlic minced
- 3 cups chicken broth
- 1^{1/2} cups heavy cream

- 4 cups broccoli finely chopped
- 1/2 teaspoon smoked paprika
- 1 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 3 ^{1/2} cups cheddar cheese

INSTRUCTIONS

- In a deep pot, add the butter and place it over medium heat. Once hot, add the onions and garlic and stir fry for 1-2 minutes, until fragrant.
- Add the chicken broth and heavy cream and finely chopped broccoli, smoked paprika, pepper, and salt and bring it to a boil. Once it begins to boil, reduce to low and simmer for 20 minutes until the broccoli is tender.
- Add the cheddar cheese in half a cup at a time until combined. Remove from the heat and serve with extra shredded cheese and chopped parsley on top.
