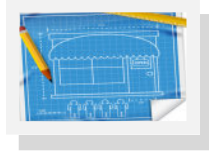

Gardening Tips

Agave

Now is the time to control the agave weevil

Last summer I was alarmed by seeing many collapsed and dead Agave plants (Agave Americana) in Florence Gardens. This surprised me as I always thought of them as being one of the toughest plants in the world! I have since learned that we have a serious pest problem in the Southwestern United States and Northern Mexico that can be fatal to these wonderful and interesting plants.

The agave snout weevil (*Scyphophorus acupunctatus*) can be devastating to these beautiful plants and a serious threat to agave farmers that grow ornamental plants and who grow agave for the production of tequila. The adult weevil is about ½ inch long and is dark brown. Being a weevil it has a long thin snout for piecing a plant and feeding on the plants juices. This makes them impossible to control if insecticide is merely placed on the outside of the plant. Female adults enter the base of the plant in springtime, late March, early April, and lay eggs which hatch into larvae and eat the plant causing damage or death. Older plants are more prone to damage.

Control of these weevils can be very difficult and unfortunately the damage isn't visible until it is too late in many cases. To stop and prevent damage to the plants, first remove any plants that are dead or damaged and clean any dead leaves on the ground. Weevils hide in debris and dead plant material. Insecticide can be used, but it must be a systemic type, taken inside the plant usually through leaves or roots. Most garden centers can give recommendations and have products that are effective against the adults and larvae. They maybe liquid or granular types and most are applied to the soil.

As always read and follow the label directions on any pesticides.

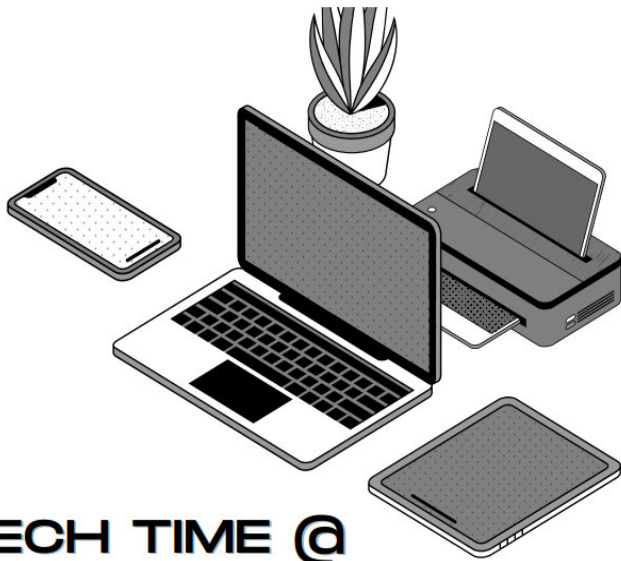

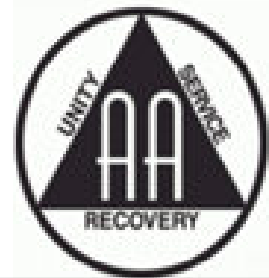

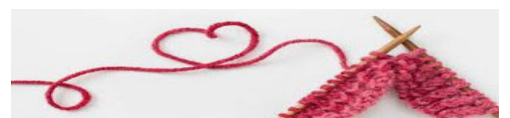


KNITTING, CROCHET, AND EMBROIDERY

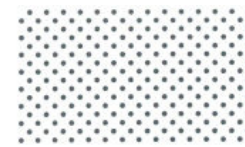
Recycles Friends UTV/ATV

- Espresso powder 1 tsp.
- Xanthan gum 1 tsp.
- Coconut flour 1/2 cup or 56 g
- Baking soda 1 1/2 tsp.
- Caramel sauce 2x recipe
- Chopped and minced pecans 1/4 cup or 28 g
- Baking powder 2 tsp.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Following the caramel recipe prepare it well and set it aside.
2. Arrange the microwave for 350 degrees F mix all the dry ingredients in a small mixing bowl and mix the sweetener properly.
3. Use the cup, add the cream to it, and mix it perfectly.
4. Take another bowl and add the eggs, coconut oil, and vanilla extract. Melt it properly, and set it aside.
5. After 5 minutes, add the coconut mixture to the non-wet mixture and combine it perfectly.
6. Transfer the mixture to the baking sheets that are prepared with parchment paper bake it for 45 minutes and leave it out from the oven.
7. Now, serve it after drizzling it with the caramel sauce, and after 5 minutes serve it.

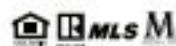
